1. Log in to the Course on Blackboard. Click Course Tools to show a large list of options. Scroll down to find **Turnitin Assignments**. Click **Turnitin Assignments**.




2. Locate the title of the assignment whose grades you want to re-sync into your grade center. To the right of the assignment title, click **Sync Grades**.
